## PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS, PHONICS AND SPELLING GAMES FOR EDUCATION ASSISTANTS

### EVENT DESCRIPTION

This all day PD session is for education assistants. The session will support EAs in implementing effective phonological awareness (PA), phonics and spelling pattern intervention for K-3 students. EAs working with Year 4-6 students for remedial spelling instruction may also benefit. The session will provide a balance between theory and practice, with examples of lessons, video observations and resource exploration included throughout. All participants attending will receive a resource CD with supporting assessment, planning and teaching resources.

### SESSION AIMS

Participants will:

- Discuss evidence based approaches to literacy instruction and intervention (theory)
- Discuss systematic PA, phonics and spelling pattern intervention - frameworks, scope and sequences
- Discuss and practice explicit teaching of skills – including video observations
- Explore and practice implementing literacy activities
