PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS INSTRUCTION K-1

EVENT DESCRIPTION

This all day PD session is for teachers and support staff including education assistants and AIEOs. The session will support staff in planning for and implementing effective Phonological Awareness (PA) instruction for K-1 students. Staff working with Year 2-6 students for remedial spelling instruction may also benefit. The session will provide a balance between theory and practice, with examples of lessons, video observations and resource exploration included throughout. All participants attending will receive a resource CD with supporting assessment, planning and teaching resources.

SESSION AIMS

Participants will:

- Discuss evidence based approaches to literacy instruction and intervention (theory)
- Explore systematic PA instruction and intervention - frameworks, scope and sequences, target setting, timetabling
- Investigate PA instruction and intervention - explicit teaching frameworks, video observation, planning
- Evaluate PA activities and intervention programs
- Apply PA assessment, goal setting and evaluation of student outcomes to their own classrooms
