## PHONICS INSTRUCTION AND INTERVENTION

### EVENT DESCRIPTION

This all day PD session is for teachers and support staff including education assistants and AIEOs. The session will support staff in planning for and implementing effective Phonics intervention for PP-3 students, with links to spelling and reading. Staff working with Year 4-6 students with speech, language and literacy difficulties may also benefit. The session will focus on phonemic awareness, phonics and sound patterns, and will provide a balance between theory and practice—with examples of lessons, video observations and resource exploration included throughout. All participants attending will receive a resource CD with supporting assessment, planning and teaching resources.



### SESSION AIMS

Participants will:

- Discuss the role of oral language in literacy development.
- Discuss systematic phonics intervention - frameworks and scope and sequences.
- Discuss explicit phonics intervention - explicit teaching frameworks, video observations and planning.
- Explore phonics resources, activities and assessment.
- Explore integrating phonics with phonemic awareness, particularly for students with language difficulties.
