THE MAGIC OF MEANING: VOCABULARY & SEMANTICS INSTRUCTION & INTERVENTION (K-2)

EVENT DESCRIPTION

This all day PD session is for teachers and support staff including education assistants and AIEOs. The session will support staff in planning for and implementing effective vocabulary instruction and intervention for students in Years K-2. Staff working with Year 3-6 students for expressive and receptive language difficulties may also benefit. The session will provide a balance between theory and practice, with examples of lessons, video observations and resource exploration included throughout. All participants attending will receive a resource CD with supporting assessment, planning and teaching resources.

SESSION AIMS

Participants will:

- Discuss evidence based approaches to vocabulary development (theory)
- Explore systematic vocabulary and semantic organisation instruction and intervention: frameworks, scope and sequences, target setting
- Review explicit vocabulary and semantics intervention: explicit teaching frameworks, video observation, planning
- Evaluate semantic organisation and vocabulary activities and resources
