GRAPPLING WITH GRAMMAR: SYNTAX INSTRUCTION & INTERVENTION (MERREDIN)

EVENT DESCRIPTION

This all day PD session is for teachers and support staff including education assistants and AlEOs. The session will support staff in planning for and implementing effective oral to written grammar instruction (Kindergarten to Year 2 focus but with strategies to support intervention Year 3 +). The content includes an emphasis on developing meta-awareness of English syntax and morphology, and explicitly teaching grammar through structured opportunities in functional contexts. The session will provide a balance between theory and practice, with examples of lessons, video observations and resource exploration included throughout. All participants attending will receive a resource USB with supporting planning and teaching resources.



SESSION AIMS

Participants will:

- Discuss oral to written grammar development
- Discuss evidence-based approaches to grammar instruction
- Review English grammar, including terminology for educators and students
- Develop knowledge of systematic and explicit grammar instruction, including morphology and sentence construction
- Workshop practical strategies for grammar instruction
- Explore grammar resources and programs
