SOCIALLY SAVVY: SOCIAL SKILLS AND PRAGMATICS INTERVENTION

EVENT DESCRIPTION

This all day PD session is for teachers and support staff including education assistants and AIEOs. The session will support staff in planning for and implementing effective social skills instruction for K-3 students. The session may also be helpful for remediation purposes, for upper primary teachers. Participants will develop knowledge of how to explicitly teach each social skills area with practical strategies for classroom use. The session will balance theory and practise, with opportunities for video observations and resource exploration throughout the session. All participants attending the PD will receive a resource CD with supporting assessment, planning and teaching resources.

- Discuss social skills theory
- Investigate systematic and explicit social skills instruction
- Apply assessment of social skills
- Consider teaching strategies
- Explore social skills resources
