NORTH EAST METROPOLITAN LDC OUTREACH SERVICE LANGUAGE LEADERSHIP SCHOOLS SERIES 2026

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Language Leadership Schools Series (LLSS) is designed specifically for educators working from Kindergarten to Year 2 (though those working with SAER students in Y3+ may benefit) – classroom teachers, Deputy Principals, Literacy Leaders, SAER Coordinators and Curriculum Leaders. The series will enhance participants' knowledge of oral language and literacy, assessment, data analysis and intervention strategies. Participants attending the LLSS must work within either the North East Metro or Wheatbelt Education District.



COURSE AIMS & STRUCTURE

This series consists of 6 full days of professional learning spread across the year. Throughout the year participants take part in action research supported by the Outreach Team. This will include developing a SMART goal in relation to school priorities, creating and implementing an action plan, collecting and analysing data and reporting on outcomes.

A school service agreement is developed collaboratively with the Outreach Service and the school which aims to support the specific needs of the Key Leader/s and their respective school. This may include intervention support and professional learning sessions delivered at their school.

CONTENT & SESSION DATES

The LLSS is structured to include a balance between practice, theory, networking, action research, and collaboration. The 6 sessions will enhance and extend participants' knowledge of best practice assessment, instructional and intervention approaches with a focus on early childhood. The full day sessions (8.30am-4.00pm) will cover the following:

Participants' leadership skills will be developed throughout the duration of the course, building their capacity to support oral language and literacy development within their schools and ensure effective implementation of intervention.

By enrolling in the Language Leadership School Series, participants commit to: participating in action research in their school, meeting face to face with their Outreach Support Officer once per term and meeting with their principal about their action research in terms 1 and 3. By allowing staff to register for the Language Leadership School Series school admin agree to: support their staff in conducting action research and meeting with their enrolled staff member (and possibly their Support Officer) regarding the participant's action research in terms 1 and 3.
